increased rapidly in the last two decades. The so-called 2nd and 1.5 generation of migrants occupy a specific and unique position in the group of newcomers. The term 1.5 generation refers to "people who immigrate to the new country before or during their early teens". A second-generation migrant is "a person who was born [...] in a country that at least one of their parents previously entered as a migrant" (Source: EC/Migration and Home Affairs).. The orientation of the abovementioned groups on the border of both cultures can cause conflict between generations, but it can also bring great opportunity and potential. The latter is the focus of the new project 2GEM or Second Generation of European Migrants!




WHAT CAN YOU EXPECT IN THE NEXT FEW MONTHS?
