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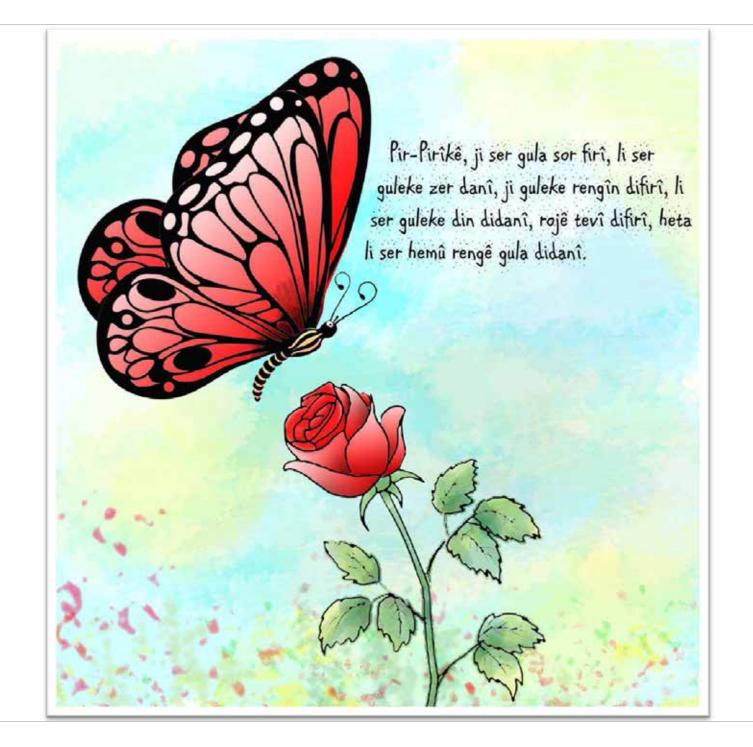
# The colour of a butterfly

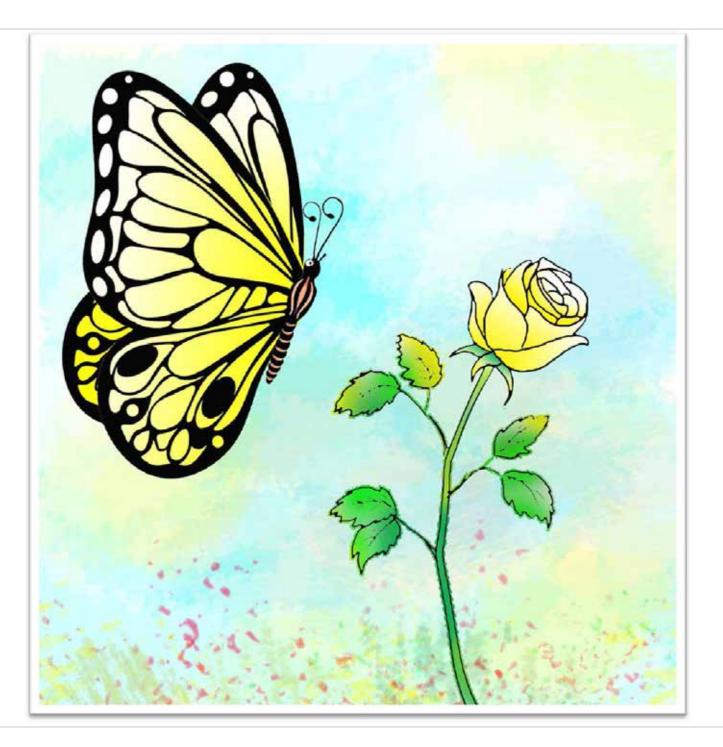

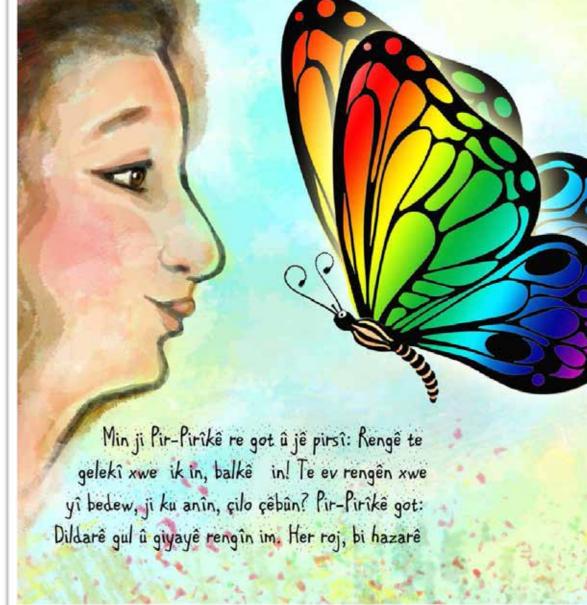
The butterfly sat on a red flower.
