Europe-wide Global Education Congress (2002)

Global education is a pedagogical approach fostering multiple perspectives based on the deconstruction of stereotypes, while building on a learner-centred approach that fosters critical awareness of global challenges and engagement for sustainable lifestyles. It is a methodology aiming at the development

of a more inclusive education, human rights education, education for sustainability, education for peace and conflict prevention and intercultural education.
